Reflections & Ryminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

There is a lot of wisdom in the words that Jesus spoke to his apostles in today's gospel:

"Take nothing for the journey, neither walking stick, nor sack, nor food, nor money, and let no one take a second tunic. Whatever house you enter, stay there and leave from there."

The reason Jesus told his disciples to "take nothing for the journey" may have been because they could travel lighter and faster without the burden of carrying a lot of possessions with them. We really should stop and think about this, because our possessions often weigh us down rather than free us. Our possessions take a lot of time, money, and effort away from our relationships with God, our family and friends, and the community that we live in.

Another reason Jesus might have told his disciples not to take anything with them for the journey though, may have been because they would have to depend on other people for their food and shelter. This meant the apostles would have a lot more interactions with the people they encountered, and it would give the strangers they met time to get to know them a little more personally. Jesus also showed his love for all of humankind in today's gospel when he sent his disciples out into the world to heal people, cure their diseases, cast out demons, and proclaim the kingdom of God. They didn't just talk about the kingdom of God, they followed up their words with actions.

As I leave for Vatican City on Tuesday the 16th, I follow the advice of Jesus and never take more than a carry-on bag even for such an international trip. In addition to meeting with various individuals, I will have the opportunity to tour the barracks, armory and chapel of the Pontifical Swiss Guards. I will keep everyone in my prayers and in my daily Masses while in Rome and Vatican City.

Social Media Threatens Children's Mental Health

In a recent June 17th, 2024 essay, Dr. Vivek Murthy, the current U. S. Surgeon General, reminded us that a "moral test of any society is how well it protects its children." Dr. Murthy observed that "the mental health crisis among young people is an emergency – and social media has emerged as an important contributor." Citing recent public health research data, he summarized that "adolescents who spend more than three hours a day on social media face double the risk of anxiety and depression symptoms, and the average daily use in this age group, as of summer of 2023, was 4.8 hours." He went on to call for a Warning Label on social media platforms, stating that "social media is associated with significant mental health harms for adolescents. A surgeon general's warning label, which requires congressional action, would regularly remind parents and adolescents that social media has not been proven safe." Dr. Murthy also outlined a number of proposed action steps for legislatures, social media companies, schools, parents and young people. 




