Welcome

Reflections & Ruminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

Today is a special Mass which I will attend as a concelebrant with Archbishop Schnurr as he celebrates his 50th anniversary as a priest. Throughout his life, he has served in many and varied ways as a priest and bishop. He comes from a small town in Iowa named Hospers. When I attended his mother's funeral there one December, I was able to see the town in about one minute due to its small size. The day of the funeral brought a high temperature of 20 degrees below zero. After Archbishop Schnurr's ordination to the priesthood, he served as a parochial vicar at the Cathedral in Sioux City, Iowa, and was sent for canon law studies at the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC. Upon his return, he served as chancellor and financial officer in Sioux City before being called to serve at the apostolic nunciature in Washington, DC. Archbishop Schnurr was then chosen to serve as Executive Secretary for the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. In 2001, he was appointed bishop of Duluth, Minnesota and then coadjutor bishop of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati in 2008 where in December 2009, he became Archbishop of Cincinnati after the retirement of Archbishop Pilarczyk. I have personally served under Archbishop Schnurr as Chancellor in 2011 and then Vicar General and continue to serve as Vicar General to this day.

Archbishop Schnurr exemplifies very well: "a good character ... quiet, solid, steady, careful about his duties, sincere, straightforward, in order, and pleasant. He is very much concerned about the Church and her mission. I am honored to be able to serve under such an outstanding man, priest and Archbishop. Congratulations to Archbishop Schnurr on his 50th anniversary to the priesthood and 23 years as a bishop. May God who has begun the good work in him bring it to completion!

The Order of Secular Franciscans (OSF)

The Catholic church has many different orders of the clergy, Jesuits, Dominicans, Franciscans and Benedictines just to mention a few. Many of these have what is known as the first order, second order and third order.

The first order consists of ordained clergy who have professed to follow a certain rule. These are Jesuit priests, Dominican priests, Franciscan priests, and Benedictine priests. The second order consists of vowed religious, brothers and sisters who have dedicated their life to the virtues of their particular order. Finally, there is the third order which consists of clergy and laity who profess to lead their lives in accordance with the charisms of their particular order. The third order includes ordained priests who are of a different order but profess to lead their lives in accordance with the Franciscan rule, for example.

On Saturday August 10th, Paul Feie will make his final profession for the Order of Secular Franciscans. This will take place at the St. Joseph Conference and Retreat Center in Tipton, Indiana during the annual Franciscan Connect Retreat being held that weekend.

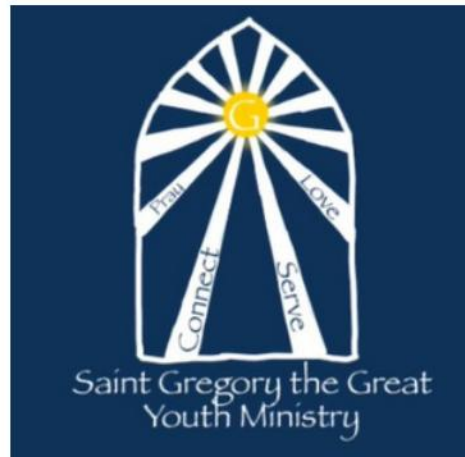
