# Reflections & Ruminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

October is Respect Life Month; a time to join together as one Catholic Church to defend the dignity of all human life, from the time we are knit together in our mothers' wombs until we take our final breaths, each moment of our lives is a gift from God. Each year the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops designates the first Sunday of October as the beginning of an annual Respect Life program.

Today the gift of life is threatened in countless ways. Those who are most vulnerable, rather than receiving the protection they deserve, are all too often seen as a burden and as expendable. As new attacks on human life continue to emerge, we can be tempted to despair, but Christ instead offers us hope. Hope is the virtue "by which we desire the kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ's promises and relying not on our own strength, but on the help of the grace of the Holy Spirit."

By virtue of this Christian hope, we can face any challenge or trial. When the seas of life swell and we are battered by the waves, hope allows us to remain anchored in the heart of God. May we hold fast to Christ our hope, from the beginning of life to its very end. Do not be afraid to stand up for Life.

## St. Gregory the Great Mental Wellness Minute

In November 2023, the USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) introduced this Novena for Mental Health for all the people of God to join together in prayer for those experiencing or impacted by mental health issues and for those who accompany them. It can be prayed at any time of year, but the entire Church is encouraged to pray this Novena in solidarity with one another from October 10 to October 18. October 10 is World Mental Health Day and this nationwide moment of prayer fittingly concludes on the feast of Saint Luke, patron saint of health care, on October 18.
