

# Reflections & Ryminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

Tuesday, February 11 is the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. The late Saint Pope John Paul II declared this day a Day of Prayer for the Sick. Illness and suffering is an immutable part of the human condition. The need to endure them in isolation, though, is not. However, illness can also sanctify, reconcile, and open hearts. Pope Francis has said that part of this is the opportunity illness provides us to truly "walk together" as "companions on the journey." Our faith calls us to fraternity with the sick.

For Catholic health providers, namely doctors, nurses and those who minister to the sick, this calling takes on even more significance. It motivates them to look for barriers to human accompaniment. In our modern world, we work every day to ensure the organized care the sick receive provides compassion more comprehensively. We do this through our hospitals, staff, volunteers, caregivers, ethics, and our processes. This institutionalized care incorporates, at its center, our mission to accompany the suffering and the sick so that in the inevitable nature of our mortality we may face these hardships together.

This Tuesday, say a prayer for all those who are sick and suffering with various diseases. Pray that the healing touch of Christ will touch their hearts and minds. Also, on Saturday, March 1, at the 3:30 pm Mass at Guardian Angels, we will celebrate the Mass with the Anointing of the Sick for the St. Gregory the Great Family of Parishes. Additional priests will be present at the Mass to facilitate the number to be anointed with the Sacrament of the Sick. More information will be forthcoming from Health Ministries.

### Catholic Inner-City Schools Education Fund Collection | February 16

The mission of the Catholic Inner-City Schools Education Fund (CISE) is to transform the lives of urban children by providing access to a strong Catholic education at designated inner-city schools and Catholic high schools. Gospel values are taught in an environment of respect, safety and discipline. CISE works with the schools to promote excellence through collaboration and accountability. Maintaining an inclusive and welcoming atmosphere is essential to CISE as 74% of CISE school students are non-Catholic and 85% are minorities. A full 86% of 8th-grade graduates are accepted into Catholic high schools; many CISE students are also among the first in their families to attend college. In addition to excellent academics, the formation of critical values such as discipline, responsibility, perseverance, respect, and cooperation that extend far beyond the years of formal education are provided in CISE schools.

### **Forming Family Councils & Next Steps**

Location: GA Undercroft | Date: February 25, 2025 Purpose: Recruitment for Family Councils | POC: Jeff Zalar

The Saint Gregory the Great Pastoral Council will hold a townhall meeting to discuss the formation of Family Councils. These Councils will administer essential services to our community. The meeting will also update parishioners on next steps in the unification process. An open-floor question-and-answer period will follow. The meeting will take place on Tuesday evening, February 25, from 7:00 - 8:30 pm in the undercroft of GA Church.

#### **Burning of Palms**

The palms we receive on Palm Sunday are blessed and are thereby a sacramental. Sacramentals are holy objects (such as the palm or a blessed statue), actions (such as making the Sign of the Cross), and gestures (such as genuflecting to the Tabernacle) in the Catholic Church that are used to increase devotion and help people draw closer to God. They are meant to sanctify everyday life and circumstances. Sacramentals can help people call on God's blessing and serve the Lord. Catholics dispose of sacramentals by burning or burying them in a way that shows respect for their sacred purpose. The burning of palms is a Catholic tradition that takes place right before Lent. The palms are burned to create ashes that are used for Ash Wednesday. The ashes symbolize repentance and mortality.

**GA** - return your palms from last Palm Sunday to the gathering space the weekend of March 1 & 2. The palms will be burned on Tuesday, March 4 at 6 pm.

**IHM** - return your palms to the table in the gathering space in Church. We will burn them in the Church courtyard after the 5 pm Mass on Saturday, March 1st. All are invited to come and participate in this pre-Lenten ritual. We hope you will join us! **SJF** - return your palms to the gathering space at SJF in February and we will get them to GA or IHM to be burned.

### Youth Mental Health First Aid Training FOR ADULTS, March 8, 2025

The St. Gregory the Great Mental Wellness Ministry is excited to offer one of the premier training courses for adults who want to support youth with mental health challenges or substance use disorders -- or just want to increase their knowledge of these conditions and their impact on individuals, families, and the community. This is important training for all adults who interact with youth – including teachers, school staff, parents, grandparents. Youth Mental Health First Aid (Youth MHFA) is an essential training component for strengthening the skills required to reach out to children and adolescents who are struggling with mental health challenges or substance use disorders.

What the Youth Mental Health First Aid course covers:

- Identifying and responding to common signs and symptoms of youth mental illness (anxiety, depression, eating disorders, ADHD, etc.)
- Identifying and responding to signs and symptoms of substance abuse
- How to interact with a child or adolescent in crisis
- How to connect youth with help
- Expanded content on trauma, addiction, and self-care; and the impact of social media and bullying

The Youth MHFA Training for Adults is on March 8, 2025 from 9 am - 3:30 pm at St. John Fisher (Resurrection Room).

# Bible Study at St. John Fisher starts February 18th!

St. John Fisher will offer The Bible Timeline: The Story of Salvation by Ascension. This study is a program that takes us on a guided journey through salvation history. Presenter Jeff Cavins will show us how fourteen of the Bible's narrative books tell the biblical story from beginning to end and will give us the keys to understanding the amazing story woven throughout Scripture. It will show us how to read and understand the entire Bible and introduce us to the wonderful narrative of Scripture in a way that will transform your life.

The study, co-led by Deacon Tom Gaier, Connie Wehmeyer, and Marty Rauen, is 25 sessions and will start with an introduction to the bible on February 18th at 10:00 am in the Resurrection Room at St. John Fisher. We will then do 12 weekly sessions with Jeff Cavins starting February 25 and finish in May. The subsequent 12 sessions will begin again in the fall and complete the study. There is no requirement that you attend all 25 sessions, or that you only sign up for the spring sessions but not the fall. However, it will be most fruitful to attend both sessions.

The total cost for the materials is \$45.00 which includes the workbook, the bible timeline chart, and a bible timeline bookmark. #### **Helping Our Refugee Neighbors**

"Long have I waited for your coming, home to me and living deeply our new lives"

By the time most of the families in Catholic Charities Refugee Resettlement Program get to Cincinnati, they have been gone from their home countries for somewhere between two and ten years. During that time, they have been shuttled from one refugee camp to another, while undergoing vigorous background checks by the UN and potential settlement countries. Eventually, the UN designates their final stop, the place they will call home.

Currently, the office in Cincinnati is working to find homes for families from Eritrea, Syria, Democratic Republic of Congo and Venezuela. The families range in size from 1 to 13! And these families need everything. They fled with nothing and have traveled with little more.

On the weekends of February 16 and February 23, the churches from the St. Gregory the Great Family are asked to help Catholic Charities of Southwest Ohio (CCSW) gather the basics to outfit the new homes for these families.

Needed items include new twin size sheet sets. comforters/blankets, bath towels and wash cloths, bed pillows, dish towels and pot holders, mops, brooms, dustpans, kitchen size trash cans (11 or 13 gallon). Items that can be gently used include cookware (especially stock pots 8 qt. or larger, can openers, cooking utensils (serving spoons, spatulas, flatware (forks, knives, spoons, knives, etc.), dishes. Please consider donating an item from this list to help our newest neighbors finally come "Home" and begin living deeply their new lives. Items can be brought to GA, IHM or SJF the weekends of February 16 and 23.

All in the St. Gregory the Great family are invited to join our community for this Lenten prayer service at 7:00 pm on Thursday, March 27th at St. John Fisher Church.






