Reflections & Ruminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

This weekend our gospel reflects on the Beatitudes.

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

Step by step, we journey on our Christian walk. Humility is the first step, a recognition of our spiritual poverty. Our hearts are receptive and amenable to the call of Christ.

"Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted."

Godly sorrow is the next step of our journey. Our heartfelt desire is for the mercy and forgiveness of our Savior, His comfort and peace.

"Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth."

Along our journey, we seek to acquire the characteristics of Christ.

"Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy."

We seek to cultivate the compassion of Christ. Unlike the worldly, merely looking out for themselves, we look to others... loving them as Jesus loves us.

"Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of Me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven."

This appears to be a retelling of the first with the same reward — the kingdom of heaven. Jesus warns His disciples that they will face opposition and persecution because of their faith in Him. Troubles and trials will come our way... all a test of our true discipleship. Yet Jesus encourages all His followers with the promised reward for living the Beatitudes... blessed happiness in this life and perfect happiness for all eternity.

NEWS AND EVENTS

Burning of Palms

The palms we receive on Palm Sunday are blessed and are thereby a sacramental. Sacramentals are holy objects (such as the palm or a blessed statue), actions (such as making the Sign of the Cross), and gestures (such as genuflecting to the Tabernacle) in the Catholic Church that are used to increase devotion and help people draw closer to God. They are meant to sanctify everyday life and circumstances. Sacramentals can help people call on God's blessing and serve the Lord. Catholics dispose of sacramentals by burning or burying them in a way that shows respect for their sacred purpose. The burning of palms is a Catholic tradition that takes place right before Lent. The palms are burned to create ashes that are used for Ash Wednesday. The ashes symbolize repentance and mortality.

GA - return your palms from last Palm Sunday to the gathering space the weekend of March 1 & 2. The palms will be burned on Tuesday, March 4 at 6 pm.

IHM - return your palms to the table in the gathering space in Church. We will burn them in the Church courtyard after the 5 pm Mass on Saturday, March 1st. All are invited to come and participate in this pre-Lenten ritual. We hope you will join us!

SJF - return your palms to the gathering space at SJF in February and we will get them to GA or IHM to be burned.

Youth Mental Health First Aid Training FOR ADULTS, March 8, 2025

The St. Gregory the Great Mental Wellness Ministry is excited to offer one of the premier training courses for adults who want to support youth with mental health challenges or substance use disorders -- or just want to increase their knowledge of these conditions and their impact on individuals, families, and the community. This is important training for all adults who interact with youth -- including teachers, school staff, parents, and grandparents. Youth Mental Health First Aid (Youth MHFA) is an essential training component for strengthening the skills required to reach out to children and adolescents who are struggling with mental health challenges or substance use disorders.

What the Youth Mental Health First Aid course covers:

- Identifying and responding to common signs and symptoms of youth mental illness (anxiety, depression, eating disorders, ADHD, etc.)
- Identifying and responding to signs and symptoms of substance abuse
- How to interact with a child or adolescent in crisis
- How to connect youth with help
- Expanded content on trauma, addiction, and self-care; and the impact of social media and bullying

The Youth MHFA Training for Adults is on Saturday, March 8 from 9 am - 3:30 pm at St. John Fisher (Resurrection Room).

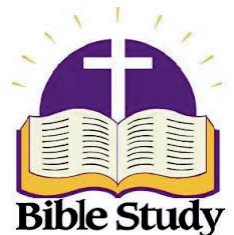
Day of Reflection | March 1

Helping Our Refugee Neighbors

"Lord, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to You?" Then He will answer them, saying, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' (Mt. 25: 45-46)

The parishioners of the St. Gregory the Great Family have an opportunity to "minister to strangers" in our city this month by donating to the collection of household items to help Catholic Charities Refugee Resettlement Services as they provide homes for newly arrived refugee families in Cincinnati.

Currently, the office in Cincinnati is working to find homes for families from Eritrea, Syria, Democratic Republic of Congo and Venezuela. The families range in size from 1 to 13! And these families need everything. They fled with nothing and have traveled with little more. On the weekends of February 16 and February 23, the churches in the St. Gregory the Great Family are asked to help Catholic Charities of Southwest Ohio (CCSW) gather the basics to outfit the new homes for these families.

Needed items include new: bath towels and washcloths, bed pillows, dish towels and potholders, kitchen size trash cans (11 or 13 gallon), mops, brooms, dustpans, twin size sheet sets, comforters/blankets

Items that can be gently used include: can openers, cookware (especially 8 quart or larger stock pots), cooking utensils (serving spoons, spatulas, knives, etc.), dishes, flatware (forks, knives, spoons)

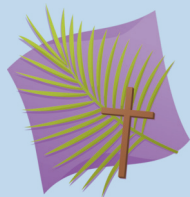
