Reflections & Ruminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday. Palm Sunday is a significant day in the Christian calendar that marks the beginning of the Holy Week leading up to Easter Sunday. It commemorates Jesus Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem, where he was welcomed by crowds of people who waved palm branches and spread their cloaks on the ground before him. The message of Palm Sunday is one of humility, sacrifice, and faith. It reminds us of the importance of being humble in the face of success and recognition, just as Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey, not a horse or chariot, to show his meekness and gentleness. It also teaches us about sacrifice, as Jesus knew that his entry into Jerusalem would ultimately lead to his crucifixion, which he willingly accepted for the sake of humanity. This sacrifice shows us the depth of God's love for us and the importance of living our lives in service to others. Finally, Palm Sunday is a reminder of faith and hope. The crowd that welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem believed in him and saw him as their savior. As we celebrate Palm Sunday, we are encouraged to have faith in God and to trust in his plans for our lives, even in times of trial and uncertainty.

Please join us in the St. Gregory the Great Family of Parishes for Holy Week. We will have a Family of Parishes Celebration on Holy Thursday to celebrate the Lord's Supper at Guardian Angels at 7:00 pm. On Good Friday, each location will have a Good Friday Liturgy of the Lord's Passion in the afternoon and there will be an evening service at 7:00 pm at St. John Fisher. The Easter Vigil will be celebrated at Immaculate Heart of Mary at 9:00 pm in which we will welcome our catechumens and candidates into the Catholic Church. The Easter Sunday schedule is the regular Sunday schedule except there is no 5:30 pm Mass on Easter Sunday at Immaculate Heart of Mary. May your Holy Week be blessed.

Autism Awareness: Sensory Friendly Masses with ASL at St. John Fisher First Sunday of the month at 12:30 pm starting May 4th

Autism is often called the "Invisible Disorder". A person with autism has no physical characteristics but may have a variety of sensory issues and developmental delays. Sometimes it is easy to assume that a child is simply acting out during Mass when, in fact, he/she is overstimulated. Families with Autism need our support. It may be difficult for them to attend Mass, and a simple word of encouragement could mean the world to them. Join us on the first Sunday of the month for our Sensory Friendly Mass with ASL (American Sign Language) at St. John Fisher starting on May 4th at 12:30 pm. All are welcome-- a special invitation is extended to any person with autism, developmental disabilities, Alzheimer's, dementia, sensory issues, or anyone in the deaf community. These Masses may include lower lighting, quiet music and/or no music, scripture from the Children's Lectionary, pictorial resources, and shorter more literal homilies; however, the biggest difference is that we try to create an environment free of stigma.

Called for More is the new St. Gregory the Great Family of Parishes Magazine!

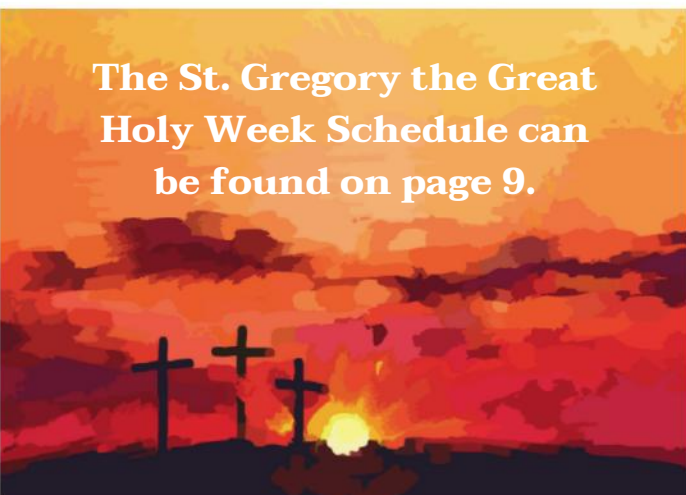

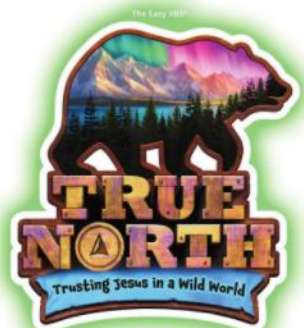
