


Reflections & Ryminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) is an essential training component for strengthening the skills required to reach out to people who are struggling with mental health challenges or substance use disorders. SPOTLIGHT

A Message from Deacon Tom

You may have seen my name on the Prayer List for the Sick or heard that I am ill. To avoid any confusion, I am sharing my situation with you. I was scheduled to have back surgery about this time, but lab work revealed I had very early-stage cancer in my bone marrow ("smoldering myeloma"). That disease is unrelated to my bulging discs. Thankfully, the cancer has not spread to any other part of my body and the doctors want to nip this cancer in the bud. I have begun immunotherapy rather than chemotherapy. There is no poison involved so the side effects are minimal, but I need to avoid crowds where viruses could affect my immune system. So, you may not see me for a while. Once we get through the therapy at the end of August, we'll deal with my ailing back. The immunotherapy has a 90+% remission rate. My Catholic oncologist told me about another Deacon he treated successfully for this disease, and he bemoans that he still must listen to that Deacon's homilies today!

To borrow from Fr. Alex, God is good all the time. All the time God is good even when life throws a curveball. All I can do is trust this is part of God's plan for me and my family. I pray that I stay open to accepting my situation. I ask you to pray not only for me, but also for my family, especially my wife, Mary Pat. Cancer does not affect just the ill person, but also everyone in that person's orbit. My family and I have now joined that club. Perhaps God has new plans for us.




