# Reflections & Ruminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

A man once said, "I know what it's like to be under the influence of alcohol. I know what it is like to be under the influence of narcotics. That stuff gave me weird dreams and even made me think my room was on fire." However, has he ever been under the influence of the Holy Spirit? Have you? Today we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost in the Church, the conclusion of the Easter Season.

What is it like to be under the influence of the Spirit? The prophet Isaiah tells us that when the Spirit is upon you, you must heal the broken-hearted, do everything you can to free captives, be brave enough to open the eyes of the blind, and show compassion to those who mourn. The prophet Joel posits that under the influence of the Holy Spirit old people will dream dreams and young people will see visions.

What if our Church was under the influence of the Spirit today? It might open wide and let all of God's creation in. We might invest ourselves in how to deal with conflict peacefully. We might take meals to or accompany a dying person at a nursing home. Under the influence of the Spirit, we would have to cure our own blindness to so many injustices that even we do not see. We know what it feels like to be under the influence of alcohol or painkillers. We are challenged to pray for our church and one another that we can also know what it is like to be under the influence of the Holy Spirit.

### A Message from Deacon Tom

You may have seen my name on the Prayer List for the Sick or heard that I am ill. To avoid any confusion, I am sharing my situation with you. I was scheduled to have back surgery about this time, but lab work revealed I had very early-stage cancer in my bone marrow ("smoldering myeloma"). That disease is unrelated to my bulging discs. Thankfully, the cancer has not spread to any other part of my body and the doctors want to nip this cancer in the bud. I have begun immunotherapy rather than chemotherapy. There is no poison involved so the side effects are minimal, but I need to avoid crowds where viruses could affect my immune system. So, you may not see me for a while. Once we get through the therapy at the end of August, we'll deal with my ailing back. The immunotherapy has a 90+% remission rate. My Catholic oncologist told me about another Deacon he treated successfully for this disease, and he bemoans that he still must listen to that Deacon's homilies today!

To borrow from Fr. Alex, God is good all the time. All the time God is good even when life throws a curveball. All I can do is trust this is part of God's plan for me and my family. I pray that I stay open to accepting my situation. I ask you to pray not only for me, but also for my family, especially my wife, Mary Pat. Cancer does not affect just the ill person, but also everyone in that person's orbit. My family and I have now joined that club. Perhaps God has new plans for us. Blessings to all! Deacon Tom
