# Reflections & Ryminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

Did you know that on the first Sunday of every month at 12:30 pm at St. John Fisher Church in our Family of Parishes, there is a Sensory-Friendly Mass? In an effort to embrace and welcome the members of our church with Autism, Down Syndrome, and other intellectual and developmental disabilities, the Archdiocese of Cincinnati has begun hosting Sensory-Friendly Liturgies. These Masses include lower lights, softer music, scripture from the Children's Lectionary, and shorter ,more literal homilies; however, the biggest difference is that we try to create an environment free of stigma. We encourage families and individuals to get up and move if needed, to bring alternative seating, fidgets or noise cancelling headphones, and to participate in the liturgy just as they are. Many people benefit from the stigma-free and less stimulating environment of a Sensory-Friendly Mass. These liturgies benefit people with sensory processing issues, autism, intellectual and developmental disabilities and adults with Alzheimer's Disease and dementia.

Some accommodations that are used are softer, slower music with less verses, homilies that are practical, tangible and literal. Incense is not used, and lights are dimmed. This has been taking place in our family of parishes since the first Sunday of May and is also open to all. The parishes that currently have Sensory-Friendly Masses are St. Maximilian Kolbe-Liberty Twp. on Sundays at 11:00 am, St. Ignatius of Loyola-Cincinnati on Sundays at 6:30 am and St. Christopher-Vandalia on the 3rd Saturday of each month at 5:00 pm. It is a blessing that our welcoming communities can meet such needs of our Catholic Christians.

To provide an update on the leadership team, the St. Gregory the Great Director of Communication, Maggie Leon-Guerrero, has accepted a position in a new industry and is departing our family of parishes on July 25. Maggie was our Pathways Team Chairperson and the liaison to the Catholic Leadership Institute assigned to us. Maggie has been an instrumental part of our St. Gregory the Great Leadership Team and a trusted collaborator for me. Please join me in wishing Maggie well in her new endeavors and praying for God's guidance as we search for our new Director of Communication.






