Welcome

Reflections & Ruminations... by Fr. Steve Angi

This coming week, August 4-7, all active priests must be present for the Convocation of Priests with Archbishop Casey at Oglebay Conference Center in West Virginia. Convocations of Archdiocesan Priests take place every three years and are multi-day. This year, Bishop Bonner, Bishop of the Diocese of Youngstown, Ohio, is the presenter for the Convocation. This is an opportunity to pray together, dialogue about essential issues and for many of our priests an opportunity to personally meet Archbishop Casey. We are fortunate to have priests who are retired or of retirement age who are not required to attend the Convocation. There will be no disruption to our normal weekday schedule thanks to the kind generosity of these priests.

Last week, I was in the Diocese of Meaux in France to meet with Bishop Lisle who has come to the United States to raise funds over the past two years to build St. Columban Church, School and Cultural Center in the Diocese of Meaux. This was a much-needed endeavor to meet the needs of those in the Diocese of Meaux and as an outreach to those visitors who come from around the world. This helps individuals to see that we are part of a universal church.

Meaux, France has a connection to the legacy of St. Columban, the Irish missionary. While St. Columban himself founded monasteries like Luxeuil in France and Bobbio in Italy, his influence extended beyond these immediate foundations. In recent times, a new church and adjoining school complex named after St. Columban have been planned and are under construction in the Val d'Europe area, near Disneyland Paris, in Seine-et-Marne, which includes the town of Meaux. This project highlights the continuing presence and impact of St. Columban's legacy in the region.

Bishop Lisle asks for our prayers for the success of this endeavor.

As a 29 year old newly ordained parish priest, Fr. McGivney witnessed his immigrant Catholic families being torn apart by the community's anti-Catholic hostilities. In 1882, with men of his St. Mary's Church Parish, New Haven, CT, he founded the Knights of Columbus to support families in the practice of their faith, to aid families in financial crisis, and to provide a way for men to live a Catholic life without fear of reprisals. He was beatified on October 31, 2020. He is now called Blessed (Bl.).

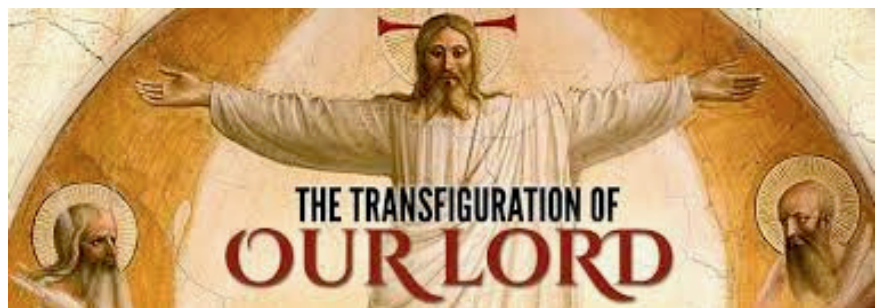
