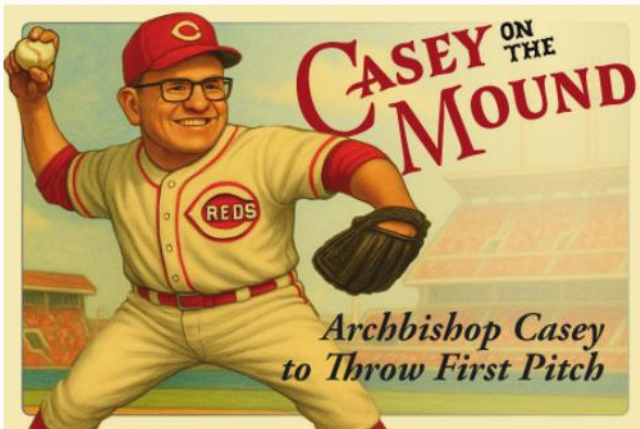

Archbishop Casey on the Mound

Join us as Archbishop Robert G. Casey of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati throws out the first pitch at an upcoming Cincinnati Reds home game. Media are invited to capture footage of Archbishop Casey's ceremonial first pitch on Saturday, August 30 at Great American Ballpark. The pitch will be around 6:25 pm, prior to the game between the Cincinnati Reds and the St. Louis Cardinals, which begins at 6:40 pm.
