Sensory Friendly Mass with ASL at St. John Fisher next Sunday, September 7th at 12:30 pm

The St. Gregory the Great Family of Parishes and the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Office for Persons with Disabilities offers a Sensory Friendly Mass with ASL (American Sign Language) on the first Sunday of every month at St. John Fisher.

Fr. Charles Onumaegbu will be presiding, and all are welcome! A special invitation is extended to any person with autism, developmental disabilities, Alzheimer's, dementia, sensory issues, or anyone in the deaf community.

This Mass may include lower lighting, quiet music and/or no music, scripture from the Children's Lectionary, pictorial resources, and shorter more literal homilies; however, the biggest difference is that we try to create an environment free of stigma. We encourage families and individuals to get up and move if needed, to bring alternative seating, fidgets or noise cancelling headphones, and to participate in the liturgy just as they are.

SPOTLIGHT

St. Gregory the Great Feast Day

Wednesday, September 3

Born around 540 AD, St. Gregory grew up with a strong spirit of faith. He lived in Rome during a period of wars, invasions by hostile tribes, famine, and destruction. The son of Gordianus, a wealthy Roman senator, like most of the upper class of his time he was well educated. But unlike many, he was generous and concerned about the poor.

When he was in his early 30s, Gregory was made the chief prefect, or governor, of Rome. He had long been attracted to the religious life, however, and so left his position before very long. He converted the family estate in Rome into the Abbey of St. Andrew, became a monk there, and founded six Benedictine monasteries on his estates in Sicily. His life of quiet and prayer did not last long; around 578 AD he was ordained one of the seven deacons of Rome and sent as the papal ambassador to Constantinople, where he served until 585 AD. When he arrived back in Rome, he was made the abbot of St. Andrew's.

Five years later the pope died, and Gregory was acclaimed pope by the clergy and the people of Rome. Unwillingly, Gregory accepted the role. He was the first pope to call himself the "servant of the servants of God." Gregory was such a good leader that he became known as Gregory the Great. Because of his political skills, learning, talents, and deep devotion to God, Gregory was able to make peace with the invading Lombards, save the city from famine by reorganizing the property and granaries of the Church, and restore order within the Church itself. Even though there were tremendous problems in Rome, Gregory was able to look beyond his land to the needs of people in foreign lands. He sent a group of monks to England to teach the faith to the people who lived there. So great was Gregory's interest in them that he has come to be called the Apostle of England, even though he himself was unable to travel there to preach.

His achievements were many and had a widespread effect, but Gregory became a saint because of his love for God, which was reflected in all that he did.

To honor St. Gregory the Great, study his writings and reflect on his teachings. His words guide us in faith and help us understand the depth of God's love and the beauty of the Church's teachings.

Perform acts of charity in his spirit for those in need. Whether through kindness, volunteering, or donations, embrace his example of selfless love and service.

St. Gregory the Great, pray for us!

O blessed Saint Gregory the Great, faithful servant of the Church and humble teacher of divine truth, we come before you on your feast day with grateful hearts. You, who guided souls with the wisdom of God's word and nurtured the bonds of faith with true charity, intercede for us in our journey toward holiness.

O Holy Father, defender of the poor and guardian of the sacred tradition, we ask you to pray for us as we strive to follow the example of your life. In our moments of spiritual weakness, grant us the strength to stand firm in our faith, and in times of doubt, light our path with the radiance of divine love.

Did You Know...

The Rosary is a prayer based on the repetition of the Lord's Prayer, the Hail Mary, and the Glory Be. During its recitation, the believer reflects upon the birth, life, death, and glory of Jesus Christ and the role of Mary. A chain of beads resembling a garland of roses gave the Rosary its name. The beads are not essential to the prayer, but they help count through fifty Hail Marys (five decades). The recitation of the traditional fifteen decades permitted unlettered Christians to imitate more simply the monastic practice of reciting all 150 psalms in weekly prayer.

In addition to meditation, the Rosary leads to petition. It implores Mary's intercession in bringing our prayers to God. As she won the cooperation of Jesus at the wedding feast at Cana, so we ask her to bring our needs to the Holy One of God.

The popes of the Church have continually cultivated the Rosary as part of the faithful's private devotion and especially in family prayer. Today we are encouraged to participate in the Mass and to pray the Rosary apart from the Eucharist.
